Families inconsolable

Bodies of 5 workers killed by terrorists in Kulgam reach their village

Heart-rending scenes were witnessed as the bodies of five workers killed by terrorists in Jammu and Kashmir's Kulgam reached their village Bahalnagar in Murshidabad district on Thursday.

The flower-bedecked coffins were brought to this village under Sagardighi block sometime after noon, as thousands of mourners from nearby and far-flung areas came to pay their last respects and share the grief of the bereaved families.

The distraught family members seemed inconsolable as they broke down on seeing the coffins that carried the mortal remains of their dear ones. State Urban Development Minister



and Kolkata Mayor Firhad Hakim accompanied the bodies from the NSC Bose International Airport in Kolkata to their village and met the kin of the deceased workers, who had fallen to terrorists' bullets at Katrasoo village of Kulgam district on Tuesday evening. Hakim wondered whether the nation has gained anything through abrogation of Article 370 of the Indian Constitution that gave special powers to Jammu and Kashmir.

Bengal workers killing pre-planned: Mamata

KOLKATA: Describing the killings of five workers from her state in the Kashmir Valley as being "pre-planned and brutal", West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee on Thursday demanded a "comprehensive inquiry" into the incident. Five workers from Bengal were shot dead by terrorists at Katrasoo village of Kulgam district on Tuesday evening. "Our workers who had gone there, had gone there in search of jobs. They were preparing to come back. But the way they have been murdered brutally, it is a dangerous incident. I think it is a pre-planned brutal murder," she told mediapersons. — Agencies

Muslims should honour Ayodhya verdict: AIMPLB

LUCKNOW: The All India Muslim Personal Law Board (AIMPLB) has appealed to the people to calmly accept whatever decision is given by the Supreme Court in the Ram Janmabhoomi-Babri Masjid title dispute case. The Supreme Court is expected to deliver its verdict before November 17, the day Chief Justice of India Ranjan Gogoi retires. AIMPLB member Maulana Khalid Rashid Firangi Mahali has said that the Supreme Court decision should be honoured and accepted by all. He has asked Muslims not to indulge in any protest or slogan shouting if the verdict does not meet their expectations. "There should be no attempt to vitiate the atmosphere in the country and caution must be exercised on the social media too. There is no need for any Muslims to be afraid or apprehensive of the consequences," he said. Shia cleric Maulana Kalbe Jawwad also said that the court decision would be acceptable to all and there should be no attempts by any party to disturb peace in the country. — Agencies

TN: NIA raids on ISIS-like group

The National Investigation Agency (NIA) on Thursday carried out searches at six locations in Tamil Nadu in connection with the alleged plot by an ISIS-inspired group to murder leaders of Hindu organisations in the ISIS Coimbatore module case and also for the links of the terror group's suspects with the Easter bombings in Sri Lanka in April this year. An NIA spokesperson in New Delhi said that the probe agency carried out searches at the houses of the associates of the charge-sheeted accused persons in the ISIS Coimbatore module case registered in September last year. The agency carried out searches at two locations in Coimbatore city, one location each in Sivaganga, Tiruchirappalli, Nagapattinam and Thoothukudi districts of the state. He said during searches, two laptops, eight mobile phones, five SIM

cards, one SD card and 14 documents have been seized. "Seized articles would be subjected to forensic examination. And the persons searched were being questioned to verify their association with the charge-sheeted accused persons besides any role in this crime," the spokesperson said. According to the NIA, the case pertains to the criminal conspiracy hatched by six charge-sheeted accused persons and their associates, with the intention of furthering the objectives of ISIS by targeting certain Hindu activists in Coimbatore. According to the central probe agency, the accused persons arrested by Tamil Nadu Police in the case in September, 2018 and charge-sheeted by NIA in February, 2019 had conducted preparations, including reconnaissance of targets, for launching such attacks, which would have caused communal disharmony and terror in the state.

MEPs expressed keen desire to know about India, terror: MEA

Clarifying on the visit of the European Union parliamentary delegation to Kashmir which has stirred controversy, the Ministry of External Affairs said on Thursday that it is part of the government's mandate to "engage with people of a wide range of social spectrum" and the MEPs had expressed a "very keen desire to know about India and how terrorism is affecting India". MEA spokesperson Raveesh Kumar, answering questions on the visit of the 23 MEPs to India, said "It was brought to our attention that the delegation is going to visit India. MEPs are directly elected and represent their constituencies directly." He said the MEPs who visited India and wanted to visit, had "expressed a keen desire

'We feel that such exchanges promote deeper people-to-people contact, and ultimately feeds into the larger relationship that any two countries would like to develop,' MEA spokesperson Raveesh Kumar said

to know more about India. They belonged to a spectrum of different countries, and different political parties, they come from opposition parties. Their meetings were accordingly facilitated, as has been done on many previous occasions."

He said it is part of the foreign policy objective of the government to promote people to people contacts. He said many visitors come and meet the Prime Minister, like former US Secretary of State Henry Kissinger met him last week. "Visitors who come do not necessarily have to come through official channels. And we have engaged and facilitated them even on occasions where the visit has not been through official channels," he said on reports that the group's visit was in a personal capacity. "It is part of the mandate to engage with people from a range of social spectrum in other countries; and the objective is very clear - that this is being done to promote our foreign policy objectives," Kumar added.

The 'witch' hunt is on

The House Intelligence Committee will hold the first set of hearings under its chair and produce a report for the Judiciary Committee, which will have the final say in drawing up the charges against Trump in what is known as Articles of Impeachment. After the full House votes to approve it with a simple majority, the Senate will hold a formal trial presided over by Supreme Court Chief Justice John Roberts on the charges. Two-thirds of the 100 Senators will have to vote to convict the President and remove him from office. As of now it seems unlikely that there will be that many Senate votes for impeachment, making the process nothing more than a political catharsis. The concerted attempt is not just to undo the last election but also influence the next one. Trump's lawyers will be allowed to participate in the Judiciary Committee's proceedings by submitting evidence and cross-examining witnesses. But if Trump prevents witnesses from appearing before it or refuses requests for documents, Trump's lawyers will not be allowed to continue examining the witnesses.

Govt bid to turn tables on whatsapp

The BJP has dared WhatsApp to reveal the names of those affected, in response to a report that those targeted in India included human rights activists who were arrested over their alleged involvement in the Bhima-Koregaon riots near Pune. The sensational disclosure emanated from a lawsuit filed on Tuesday by WhatsApp in a California federal court against NSO Group, which allegedly developed the spyware. The lawsuit has disclosed names of over a dozen journalists, Dalit activists, lawyers and academics in India who had been alerted by the messaging app in May 2019 that their phones were under surveillance. Information Technology and Law Minister Ravi Shankar Prasad was the first to express concern, saying WhatsApp has been asked to explain how it was safeguarding the privacy of Indian citizens. He tweeted: "The Government is concerned at the breach of privacy of citizens on the messaging platform WhatsApp. We have asked it to explain the breach and what is it doing to safeguard the privacy of millions of Indian citizens." Instead of issuing an official press note, Prasad resorted to make announcement on the social media and that prompted the Congress to voice its suspicions about the government. It said: "Right to privacy is being blatantly attacked under the BJP rule. When they failed to pass laws to snoop on citizens, the next step was to allow secret spying. The government must be held accountable for its actions." Minister Prasad retorted: "Those trying to make political capital out of it need to be gently reminded about the bugging incident in the office of the then eminent Finance Minister Pranab Mukherjee during UPA regime. Also a gentle reminder of the spying of the then Army Chief Gen. V. K. Singh." "These are instances of breach of privacy of highly reputed individuals, on personal whifms and fancies of a family," he added.

Govt is scared and scaring citizens...

"This is when I took the message seriously. I read articles on this subject and realised the seriousness of the issue. All this while I thought, I am a citizen who has not done any wrong or spoken ill, so nothing will happen to me. I am not even middle-class and we are backward in technology, still it has happened to me. What they have done is dirty. There is a right to privacy in a democracy and it has been breached stealthily.

Such things happen in military regimes. Who do we trust?" questioned Jadhav. The names now coming forward are those of some journalists, artists, activists and lawyers who are defending activists arrested in the Bhima-Koregaon case of January 1, 2018. The government, in its chargesheet, has claimed it has 'digital evidence' against the arrested activists. The lawyers defending the activists say, this expose of cellphone and data hacking could have been a deliberate ploy to plant evidence. Advocate Shalini Gera who is defending Sudha Bharadwaj in the Bhima-Koregaon case was shocked when WA informed her she too was vulnerable. "I was alarmed, it is not good to know somebody is eager to find out about you. Especially, when in Sudha's case the government is speaking of digital evidence. This leaves you feeling this could have been their modus operandi of what they wanted to do," said Gera. Echoing her sentiments, is advocate Nihalsing Rathod, who has said Surendra Gadling was the government's target and claims that digital evidence was planted against Gadling. "Gadling was their target and they have planted ridiculous lies. Now they are trying to implicate more people. Moreover, they did not stop at WA, Facebook, Gmail but also other media," said Rathod. Rathod had first filed a complaint with an Android support group on March 28, against the video calls he had been receiving from unknown international numbers which he suspected, were hacking into his cellphone. "I am getting video calls from unknown international numbers...I have not been picking up the call, but it seems they are stealing my data..." wrote Rathod.

its demand for 50:50 power-sharing. The BJP has offered it the post of deputy CM and 16 cabinet berths, a move which has irked the Sena no end. In a veiled attack on the BJP, Sena chief Uddhav Thackeray said on Thursday, "Mukhyamantri padacha amarapatta gheoon kuni aalee naahi (Nobody has come wearing an 'immortal CM' tag)". This clearly means the Sena is exploring other options. Immediately after election as the Sena's legislature party leader, Eknath Shinde too has underscored the need for an agreement between both parties. The Sena's mouthpiece Saamna, too, in its editorial, had made a strong pitch for the CM post. "The BJP's policy for its allies is Use and Throw," it declared in its editorial. A Sena delegation met Governor Bhagat Singh Koshyari, ostensibly to demand immediate relief for rain-affected farmers. But this meeting is being seen as a display of strength before the governor, keeping in mind the possibility of government formation. Uddhav Thackeray could not resist voicing his disappointment and said he is yet to hear from the BJP. The BJP had claimed that CM Devendra Fadnis would personally call Uddhav shortly. But instead of reaching out to the Sena, it has hinted at the appointment of two deputy CMs, one from the Sena and another from the BJP. The proposal is to appoint Chandrakant Patil as deputy CM; he will also be No.2 in the cabinet, while the third position will be given to the Sena nominee. This move will undermine the importance of the post given to Sena and create a buffer between its nominee and the CM in the form of Chandrakant Patil.

More mlas join the BJP bandwagon

the BJP is busy poaching and enticing their MLAs. Hitenra Thakur-led Bahujan Vikas Aghadi (BVA), Peasants and Workers Party (PWP), independent candidates Ravi Rana and Sanjay Shinde were part of the Congress and the NCP alliance until recently. But both BVA and PWP legislators have now extended support to the BJP BVA won three seats from Palghar district. Kshitij Thakur, Hitenra Thakur's son and a legislator from Nalaspada, also attended a meeting hosted by CM Devendra Fadnis at his official residence. Shyamsundar Shinde, the PWP legislator from Loha in Nanded district, and Ravi Rana, an independent from Amravati, won the election with the Congress-NCP support. But they, too, have walked out. Independent legislators Geeta Jain from Mira Bhayandar, Kishor Jorgewar from Chandrapur, Vinod Agrawal from Gondia, Rajendra Raut from Barshi, Prakash Awade from Ichalkaranji and Sanjay Shinde from Karmala have also switched their loyalties.

A neighbour, Javed Malik, who witnessed the incident and tried to intervene, also sustained injuries. Soon, public began to gather and to avoid being caught, Saurabh and Mishra fled, running towards Goregaon (East) in the Aarey jungle area. The locals rushed the couple to the civic-run Shatabdi Hospital, where Nandlal was declared dead on arrival, while Urmila, whose condition was critical, is said to be recuperating. The Kanojias' neighbours said, Saurabh and Mishra, both worked as autorickshaw drivers for their landlord, Bhanupratap Singh. One of the neighbours said, "Both of them have been troublesome ever since they moved in a few weeks ago. Last week, they got into a fight with the Kanojias over throwing garbage and had then threatened to kill them." When police enquired with the landlord, he claimed he had not run a background check on the accused, but both are said to be from Uttar Pradesh. Malad Police booked Saurabh and Mishra under relevant sections of the Indian Penal Code for murder (section 302), attempt to murder (section 307), voluntarily causing hurt by dangerous weapons (section 324) and common intention (section 34). Police have questioned the accused duo's friend, who had introduced them to the landlord. Officers of Unit 12 of the crime branch have also been roped in to conduct a parallel investigation in the case and are on the lookout for the absconding duo.

"I was asked to stand in a group photo by the High Commissioner's wife despite my hesitation, and a huge issue was created over this, blaming me for intentionally wanting to be part of the said event, even though I was invited for it. Prasad also feels that it's time that Engineer behaved his. "Someone at the age of 82 should show maturity and enjoy the progress of Indian cricket from his time to the current day."

NIRBHAYA GANGRAPE: CONVICTS COULD BE SENT TO GALLOWS SOON

The death penalty to the four remaining convicts in the Nirbhaya gangrape case will soon be carried out if not challenged before the President within seven days, Tihar jail authorities said. The Tihar Jail administration has issued a notice to the convicts in this regard. "Three of the four convicts are lodged in Tihar jail while the fourth convict is in Mandoli's jail number 14. The Delhi High Court as well as Supreme Court have upheld the death sentence

slapped by the trial court," Sandeep Goel, Director General, Tihar Jail, told IANS. The convicts could have filed a petition challenging the death penalty and also a review petition. However, all the convicts have not sought a review of the sentence. They could have prayed for mercy from the President seeking commutation of death sentence to life imprisonment. "All the four convicts have not taken a step seeking a commutation of capital punishment into any other sentence. The jail has notified them," Goel said.
